

FOURTH EUROPEAN SYMPOSIUM IN CELTIC STUDIES

CALL FOR PAPERS

The Department of Celtic Studies (Institute of English, American and Celtic Studies) of the University of Bonn will host the **Fourth European Symposium in Celtic Studies** from **27th to 30th August 2025**.

We invite papers on any aspect of Celtic Studies, including linguistics, language didactics, literature, history, archaeology and culture from any period (20 min. paper and 10 min. discussion). We also welcome proposals for 90-minute-long thematic sessions, round tables, and workshops. The conference languages will be German, English, French, and all Celtic languages. Please note that simultaneous interpretation of papers will not be available; we would thus kindly ask all speakers to prepare their slides and handouts in English. The symposium will be held as an in-person event.

All proposals will be peer-reviewed. Please note that the number of slots is limited, therefore the organizing committee may possibly have to make an additional selection.

Chosen abstracts will be made publicly available as a booklet of abstracts, for which we will also need the following information:
